

.CHETNOLE HOME FLOOD WATCH SCHEME

Chetnole Home Watch scheme was reorganised in 2008 in line with Dorset Police Authority [DPA] guidelines. 11 Watch Areas cover the whole Parish, each supported by a volunteer co-ordinator [see below]. The contact details of participating residents in each Watch Area are listed on pages 2 -12. Village maps available on request. In 2015 a Flood Warden Scheme was added, with 4 Flood Wardens registered according to Environment Agency [EA] guidelines . Dorset Alert police messages and EA flood warnings are emailed to residents by Watch Coordinators and Flood Wardens respectively . Whenever floodwater or groundwater causes a hazard, volunteers* will endeavour to put temporary flood warning signs in place. Residents may collect filled sandbags from the Community sandbag store behind the cricket pavilion, accessible from Church Path.
